

All visitors with a valid e-ticket who are certified as vaccinated, recovered or tested (so-called VCR status) can participate in the event. **And here's how it works:**

Ticket purchase and registration

Register in the online ticket store and, if necessary, upload QR code certificate* to activate the ticket for direct access to the trade fair.



Admission control at the entrance

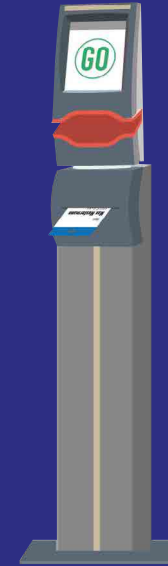
Fast Lane

Only for ticket holders who have already uploaded their digital VCR certificate* in advance in the online registration/ticket store.

Clearing Lane

Manual verification of e-ticket and VCR proof (e.g. vaccination certificate, regional digital vaccination certificate, test certificates, recovered people).

Waiting times must be planned here.



Safety instructions on site



1.5 meter safety distance



Hand hygiene (washing and disinfecting)



Adhere to cough and sneeze etiquette



Mouth and nose covering



Refrain from handshakes and hugs



Contactless payment wherever possible

Valid VCR certificates

Tested*:

- Negative test result (antigen test not older than 24 hours; PCR test not older than 72 hours)
- Self-tests are not permitted

Vaccinated*:

- Proof of complete vaccination longer than 14 days
- Analogue vaccination certificates and digital vaccination certificates with a vaccine approved in the EU are valid

Recovered*:

- Positive PCR test with date (at least 28 days old, but no more than six months ago).
- Or official notice of isolation order based on a positive PCR test (no more than six months ago) together with a subsequent negative test

Children and young people:

- Children and young people can attend the event with registration, their own ticket as well as VCR proof
